The 3rd International Modernization Forum: Modernization and Human Development (IMF 2019) will be held at China Hall of Science & Technology in Beijing, capital of China, in May 24-26, 2019. The China Center for Modernization Research of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, the Center for World Modernization Process of Peking University, the Center for Comparative Studies of Modernization of Fudan University, Theory and Modernization Magazine (Tianjin of China), and the Association for Modernization Study of China Society for Future Studies etc. are the co-sponsors of the IMF 2019.

Up to now, three invited keynote speakers and one guest speakers have been confirmed.

Prof. Alberto Martinelli: professor Emeritus of Political Science and Sociology in the University of Milan, Italy. He is the president of the International Social Science Council, UNESCO and president of the International Sociological Association. His topic of speech is "The European social model: the evolution of the welfare state in the European Union".

Prof. Jose Antonio Ocampo: professor of Professional Practice in International and Public Affairs and Director of the Economic and Political Development Concentration at the School of International and Public Affairs, Columbia University. Prior to this appointment, he served in a number of positions in the United Nations and the Government of Colombia, most notably in the United Nations as Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs and Executive Secretary for the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean. His topic of speech is "*Social Protection in Latin America*".

Prof. Chuanqi He: the academican of International Eurasian Academy of Sciences, the founder and director of China Center for Modernization Research, Chinese Academy of Sciences; the founder and chief of research group for china modernization strategy. His topic of speech is "Periodic Table of the Human Civilizations".

Guest speakers: Prof. Nicola Pasini from University of Milan.

IMF 2019 will focus on five themes: (1) Human Modernization; (2) Education Modernization and Human Development; (3) Health Modernization and Human Development; (4) Ecological Modernization and Human Development; (5) Modernization and Quality of Life.

The proceedings of IMF 2019 will be published as *Global Modernization Review* (English) and *World Modernization Report* (Chinese) by Science Press in China.
